



Progress Update:

New Traffic Pattern Coming Soon to Interchange 10

In October, access to the northbound and southbound New York State Thruway (I-87/I-287) in South Nyack will be reconfigured. The current southbound on-ramp from South Broadway will be permanently closed. The exact date will be announced in the coming weeks.

- In the new configuration, vehicles will be able to access the Thruway in both directions from a new signalized intersection at Route 9W and Hillside Avenue.
- Hudson Link riders will use new bus stops on South Franklin Street Extension (the current stop at Clinton Avenue and South Broadway will no longer be in service).

FROM SOUTH NYACK

1. Follow South Franklin Street Extension to Hillside Avenue.
2. Turn left at the traffic light onto Hillside Avenue.
3. Turn left at the traffic light onto Route 9W north.
4. Follow signs to the northbound or southbound Thruway.

1. Travel south on Hillside Avenue.
2. Turn left at the traffic light onto Route 9W north.
3. Follow signs to the northbound or southbound Thruway.



FROM PIERMONT/NEW JERSEY

1. Travel north on Route 9W.
2. Follow signs to the northbound or southbound Thruway.
